Dear Friends of Natick Wrestling,

In a matter of days it will be time to open the 2009/2010 wrestling season. Practices have begun at the high school and our younger wrestlers (the Natick Bulldogs) have also started to practice. I am writing to you to ask for your support of Natick wrestling through your membership in the Natick Wrestling Association.

Natick wrestling has a long and proud tradition and the 2008/2009 season was no exception. The Red and Blue high school wrestlers won their 10th consecutive Bay State League Title and finished an impressive runner-up in the State Division II team tournament. The team had two Division II state champions (Travis Moran and Eric Davidson) and Davidson, along with Mike Gibson, qualified to participate in the New England Championships where they both had strong showings. The Natick Bulldogs had a large, enthusiastic group of young wrestlers who represent the future for Natick wrestling. The Natick Wrestling Association sponsored the 5th annual Edward J. Deeley Memorial Wrestling Tournament which attracted nearly 300 wrestlers in grades K-8. Wrestling is indeed alive and well in Natick!

The Natick Wrestling Association (NWA) was formed in 1998 with the goal of creating a greater appreciation and awareness of wrestling in Natick. The NWA works to support wrestling at all levels. Among other activities, the NWA helps provide funding for summer wrestling opportunities, scholarships for two graduating seniors, wrestling banquets, and traveling expenses not covered by the athletic budget (trips to New York tournaments and overnight stays for the wrestlers at state level tournaments, for example). Each year we solicit friends, families and supporters of wrestling in Natick to become members of the NWA. Your membership plays an important role in helping the NWA support both the Natick High School and Natick Bulldogs wrestling programs. The NWA is a non-profit 501(c)(3) organization and thus your membership donations are tax-deductible.
